The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre – Liverpool opened in 2020 and positioned its flagship 'state-of-the-art' hospital at the heart of Knowledge Quarter Liverpool, demonstrating the Trust's commitment to taking its place at the forefront of healthcare and innovation. I.E.D. Disciplines

I.E.D. Installations Group have been brought in to take down a link tunnel that had initially been installed during the pandemic to enable patients to get from one building to another without having to go into the outdoor environment.

To do this I.E.D. were tasked.

- ❑ Disconnecting all electrical equipment including power, lighting, CCTV and door entry
- ❑ Take down the tunnel structure and remove and dispose of from site.
- ❑ Repair the now external flooring.
- ❑ Install new fencing.
- ❑ Install new CCTV cameras.
- ❑ Refeed existing refrigeration units and lighting.

All works were completed on budget and to a schedule of 6 weeks.
